Booya is set for Saturday, October 10 and we still could use more volunteers. We will be starting food prep (chopping) Thursday, October 8 about 3:00 PM until done.

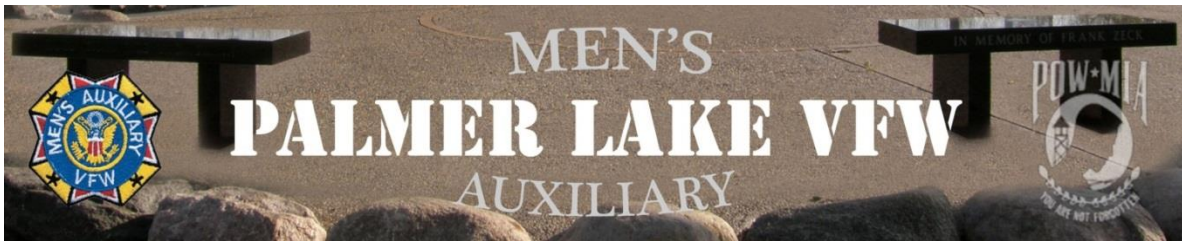
